

<u>Second Reading:</u> 1 Thessalonians 3:12 – 4:2. Conduct yourself in a way pleasing to God.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 21:25-28. 34-36. Be ready for the second coming.
